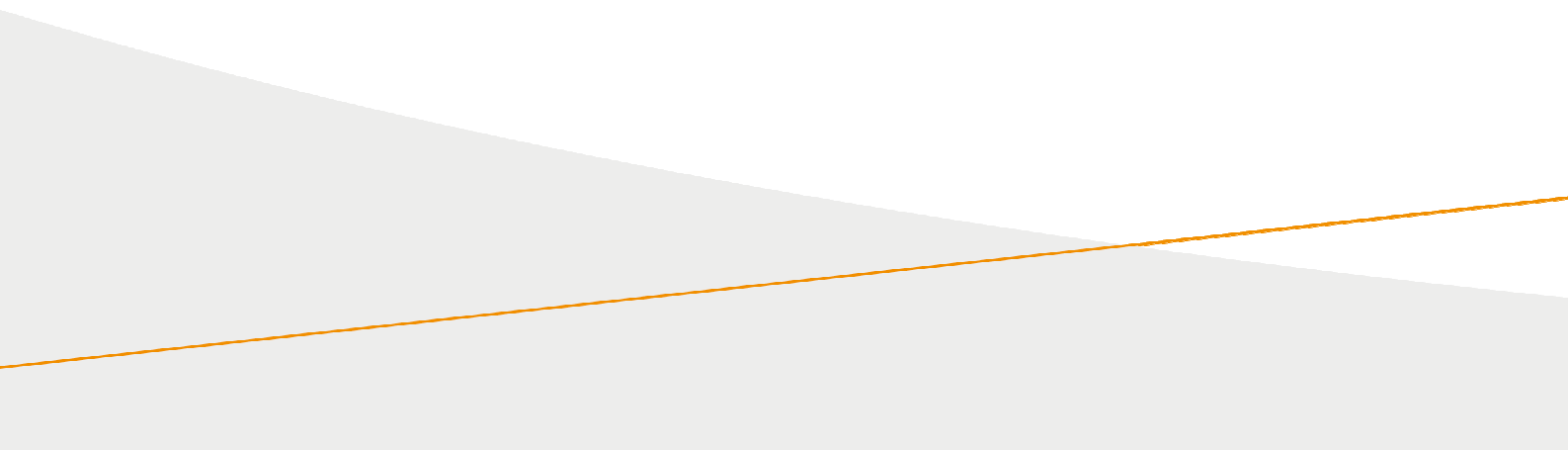

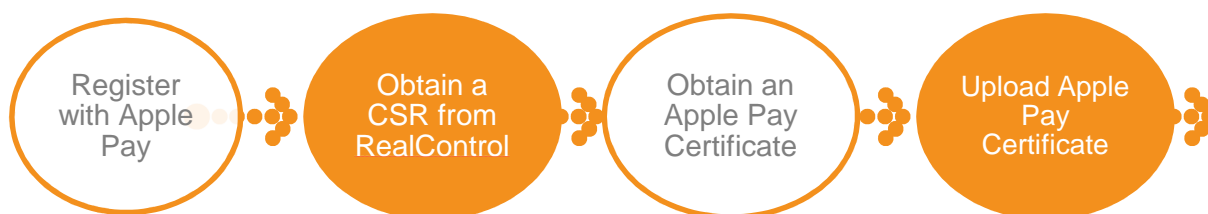

## 1. GETTING STARTED IN 4 STEPS

Apple Pay provides a simple and secure way for customers to buy physical goods and services within apps on iOS devices. Developers can now implement Apple Pay with Realex Payments and this user guide is designed to provide a simple step-by-step approach to get started.



### 1.1 REGISTER WITH APPLE PAY


Getting started with Apple Pay is simple. To start, you need an [Apple Developer Account](#). Then, in order to process transactions with Apple Pay you need to register a Merchant Identifier with Apple Pay.

This merchant ID identifies that you are able to accept Apple Pay payments. The public key and certificate associated with your merchant ID is used as part of the payment process to encrypt payment information.

## 1.2 OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE SIGNING REQUEST (CSR) FROM REALCONTROL

Once you have your merchant ID from Apple, you can then submit a Certificate Signing Request (CSR) from RealControl. It is created from public and private keys that will be used to encrypt and decrypt payment tokens.

You can obtain a CSR file from Realex Payments through [RealControl](#) > Client Settings > Apple Pay > Obtain New CSR. Choose "Obtain New CSR" and a .certSigningRequest file will automatically download.

**APPLE PAY**

In order to process transactions with Apple Pay you first need to register a Merchant Identifier via [Certificates, Identifiers & Profiles](#). 

## 1.3 OBTAIN AN APPLE PAY CERTIFICATE

Once you have your newly downloaded CSR in place you can obtain an Apple Pay Certificate from the Apple Developer site via [Certificates, Identifiers & Profiles](#).

## 1.4 UPLOAD THE APPLE PAY CERTIFICATE

Once you have obtained your Apple Pay certificate, you can upload the certificate back to RealControl. Go to [RealControl](#) > Client Settings > Apple Pay > Certificate Signing Request
